



A mind map is a diagram used to visually organise information. Though usually ideas are positioned in a certain hierarchy, I prefer to show them in a timely manner, so I use the clockwise description.

This ticking timeline frame to liaise ideas allows the reader to connect the dots (well... the honeycombs) naturally, from top right down and then up left and back to the top again! Perfect honeycomb circle!

Though the single concept in the middle draws the attention on the main topic of discussion, the real party is on the sides! The reader is invited to chat with the author's inner voice.

I used the honeycomb pattern as nature prefers to create and unfold itself in beautiful hexagons.
